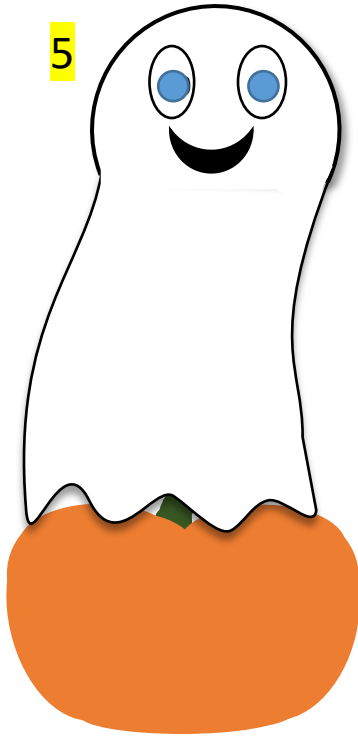

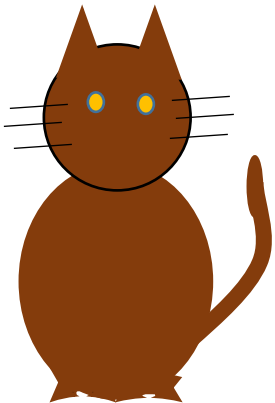

1. The pumpkin is between the two cats.  
The cats are next to the pumpkin.  
The gray cat is to the left of the pumpkin.  
The black cat is to the right of the pumpkin.
2. The ghost is under the pumpkin. (The ghost is below the pumpkin.)
3. The ghost is in front of the jack-o'-lantern.  
The jack-o'-lantern is behind the ghost.  
The cat is behind the jack-o'-lantern.  
The jack-o'-lantern is between the cat and the ghost.
4. The black cat is inside the jack-o'-lantern.
5. The ghost is on the pumpkin.
6. The jack-o'-lantern is next to the black cat/to the left of the black cat.  
The jack-o'-lantern is near the black cat/close to the black cat.
7. The brown cat is far from the jack-o'-lantern.
