







**Beginning English Lesson 6: Common Questions**

Learn how to ask and answer common questions.

In English, we have six *question words* – these are words that we use when we ask questions. They are **who**, **what**, **when**, **where**, **why**, and **how**.

Question Word	Used For . . .	Example
<b>Who</b>	People 	<i><b>Who</b> is speaking?</i> Mike is speaking.
<b>What</b>	Things 	<i><b>What</b> do you like to eat?</i> I like to eat pizza.
<b>When</b>	Time 	<i><b>When</b> is class?</i> Class is at 7:00 p.m.
<b>Where</b>	Places 	<i><b>Where</b> can I buy food?</i> You can buy food at the supermarket.
<b>Why</b>	Answer 	<i><b>Why</b> are you not working today?</i> I am not working today because I am sick.
<b>How</b>	Explanations or directions 	<i><b>How</b> do I make a sandwich?</i> You use two pieces of bread, cheese, and meat.

Here are some examples of questions and answers.

Question	Answer
<i>What is your name?</i>	My name is Sandy.

Question	Answer
<i>Where do you live?</i>	I live in Kennett Square.

Question	Answer
<i>Why are you wearing a sweater?</i>	I am wearing a sweater because it is cold outside.

Question	Answer
<i>Where do you work?</i>	I work at the Kennett Library.
